

The 3-letter fragments given can be arranged to form songs associated with well-known female singers. The strings of numbers give the enumeration and order of the songs:

WALKING ON BROKEN GLASS	(Annie Lennox)
THAT I WOULD BE GOOD	(Alanis Morissette)
WND BENEATH MY WINGS	(Bette Midler)
SOMETHING TO TALK ABOUT	(Bonnie Raitt)
I FEEL THE EARTH MOVE	(Carole King)
GIRLS JUST WANT TO HAVE FUN	(Cindi Lauper)
DIFFERENT DRUM	(Linda Ronstadt)
GENIE IN A BOTTLE	(Christina Aguilera)
MAKING LOVE IN THE AFTERNOON	(Karen Carpenter)
EVERGREEN	(Barbara Streisand)
COMPLICATED	(Avril Lavigne)
SINCE U BEEN GONE	(Kelly Clarkson)

Note that each singer's initials are represented in the circle of letters. Each pair may be interpreted as a semaphore position (a language that sailors know well). The example below shows initials for Annie Lennox, forming the semaphore for "I".

Taken in list order, letters spell "inspect AERIE", which is the final answer.
