The first word in each set of clues (shown in proper order above) can have a fragment removed and be rearranged to form the second word. Similarly, the second word can be shortened and rearranged to give the third word. In each set of clues, the deleted fragments are, in some order, a single letter and the letters in the word MAN (pesky cannibals).

The lengths of the shortest words in each set are unique, allowing the sets to be placed in the diagram . Reading the single removed letters top-to-bottom spells the answer BROAD STAIRS.
