Each string of letters is formed by interlacing the names of two works of performing, cinematic or visual art associated with a particular nation. In many cases the works are of a genre particularly associated with that nation. Enumerations for the titles are given, and the strings are alphabetized by nation. When the ttles have been extracted, a trigram remains for each:
