## The Tailor's Home- SOLUTION (BASMATI / XIA)

Each grid contains the name of a comedian or comedienne, Boggle-style. Grids are arranged alphabetically by comic. In each case, there is one unused letter, and one letter that is incorrect. Each position in the grid is used exactly twice for an unused letter. In the grids that share that unused position, the incorrect letters may be corrected by swapping one tile between the two grids (e.g. the D/Y tile in the WANDA SYKES/JIMMY KIMMEL pair). Grid pairs should then be ordered by the position of the unused letters, left-to-right, top-to-bottom. The order in which to read the letters within each pair must be determined by the solver, but it might be noted that each pair is female/male, with the female's letter being taken first. Unused letters read this way spell the message THE SOLUTION: BASMATI. Reading the corrected letters from each grid in the same order gives the message DYNASTY BEFORE SHANG, a reference to ancient China's XIA dynasty.
