

ORANG BUNIAN SOLUTION – SMACKER / YIDDISH

Each image has had a person removed through the magic of Photoshop:

Purple: Albert Einstein
Yellow: Joffrey Baratheon
Light Blue: Edgar Allan Poe
Pink: Greta Thunberg
Orange: Alfred Hitchcock
Red: George W. Bush
Dark Green: Channing Tatum
Dark Blue: Benjamin Franklin
Light Green: Christa McAuliffe

Boxed numbers on the second page should be used to index into the missing person associated with the color of the box. All of the resulting letters fall into the A-G range, and may be treated as musical notes. Arrows pointing to the upper left or right indicate flats or sharps, respectively. An upward-pointing peak on the box indicates that the note should be considered in the octave above the standard middle C octave, with a double peak indicating two octaves above. Timing of individual notes is not given.

Resulting melodies are all parts of songs which are notable for having passages that are whistled. Use the letters to the right of the melody lines to index into the song titles:

Reading column by column, the indexed letters spell "Answers are SMACKER and YIDDISH".
