















CITY OF BRASS SOLUTION - WAYSIDE, LAXEST, SALVAGING

Like brass, the images suggest certain other "alloys"; that is, things with two distinct components. One component is given on the left, the other is missing, and the totality is given on the right. From the top left down: BLUE + YELLOW = (Clue's Mr.) GREEN; HOUSE + SENATE = CONGRESS; HORSE + DONKEY = MULE, (Russell) HITCHCOCK + (Graham) RUSSELL = AIR SUPPLY; MAN + FISH = (Ethel) MERMAN; O.J. + VODKA = SCREWDRIVER; ROOT BEER + ICE CREAM = FLOAT. Indexing into the missing components by the numbers given at left spells WAYSIDE. Ordering letters crossed by connecting each pair alphabetically by missing component spells LA, XE, ST, SAL, VA, GI, NG, or LAXEST and SALVAGING.
